Fifteen community members honored by Maps Community Foundation

Foundation awards grants to nonprofits in recognition of community service

SALEM, Ore. 18 August 2022 — Mid-Willamette Valley nonprofits are benefiting this summer thanks to the Maps Community Foundation's Community Awards program. The Foundation is awarding \$15,000 in grants to local nonprofits in recognition of community members who "Make a Difference." Annually, the Foundation honors 15 community members in the region who are an inspiration through their volunteerism or employment.

Each winner has selected a local nonprofit to receive a \$1,000 grant. In addition, each winner receives a gift that includes locally produced items. This year, 15 nonprofits received grants for projects such as housing for unsheltered individuals; advocacy for people who are deaf, blind, or hard of hearing; youth sports; wildfire relief efforts and arts education.

Maps Community Foundation Executive Director Kim Hanson said, "Each awardee is such an inspiration; it has been a privilege to get to know their give-back stories and to fund such a diverse group of nonprofits that are truly making our community healthier, stronger and more vibrant."
